- La Política de Cohesión se ejecuta a través de 4 fondos específicos
- Presupuesto de **392 000 millones** de euros para 2021-2027 (1/3)
- Su objetivo es la convergencia y la reducción de las disparidades entre los Estados miembros y entre sus regiones.

- Gestión compartida y Programación - No financiar proyectos individuales sino programas nacionales plurianuales alineados con los objetivos y prioridades de la UE

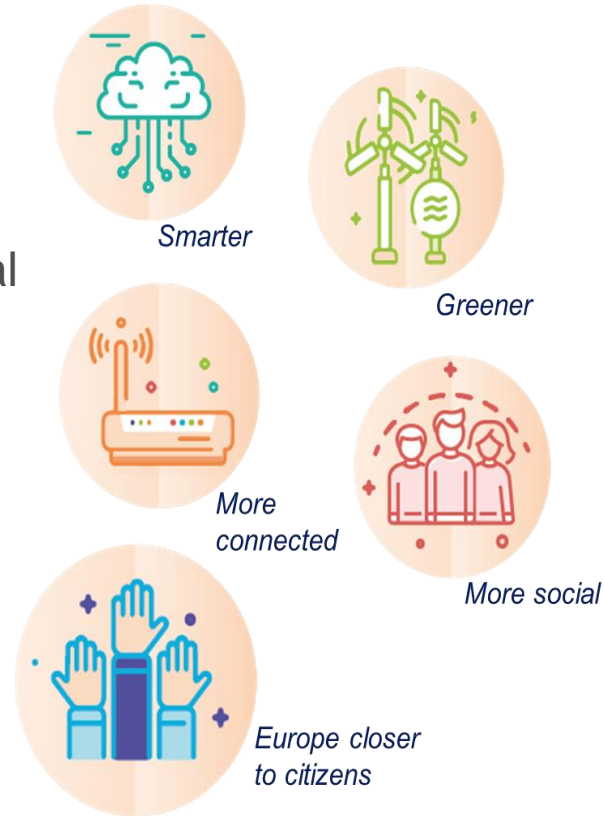
Objetivo Político 5 ‘Una Europa más cercana al ciudadano’

- Objetivo específico 5.1 – Fomentar la sostenibilidad resiliencia económica, social y medioambiental en el contexto urbano
 - Diferentes enfoques territoriales (distrito, municipio y áreas urbanas funcionales)
 - Flexibilidad temática – enfoques integrados, a medida del territorio
 - En base a estrategias urbanas diseñadas e implementadas por ciudades

Artículo 11 sobre Desarrollo Urbano Sostenible

- Min. 8% de la asignación FEDER nacional debe de ser dirigida al desarrollo territorial integrado enfocado en áreas urbanas
 - Para abordar de manera más eficiente los *retos económicos, medioambientales, climáticos, demográficos y sociales* que afectan a las áreas urbanas, con especial atención a las *transiciones verde y digital*

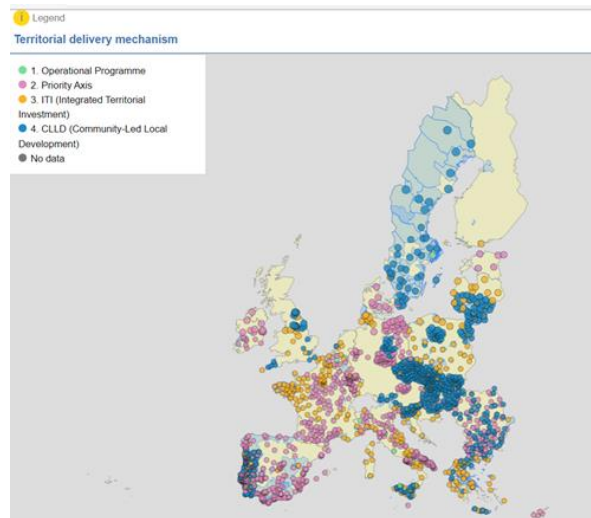
Dimensión verde del desarrollo urbano sostenible

- **Contribución a objetivos climáticos:** 30% Fondo Europeo de Desarrollo Regional y el 37% del Fondo de Cohesión
- **Objetivo Político 2 «Una Europa más verde» cubriendo:**
 - Medidas de eficiencia energética y reducción de emisiones de efecto invernadero, energías renovables
 - Adaptación al cambio climático, prevención de desastres y resiliencia
 - **Protección y preservación de la naturaleza, biodiversidad e infraestructura verde, incluyendo en áreas urbanas, y reduciendo todas formas de polución**
 - **Movilidad urbana sostenible y multimodal**
- **Fondo de transición Justa:** apoyar a las regiones más afectadas por la transición hacia la neutralidad climática.
- **Nuevos retos derivados de la transición sistémica, Nuevo Bauhaus Europeo.**

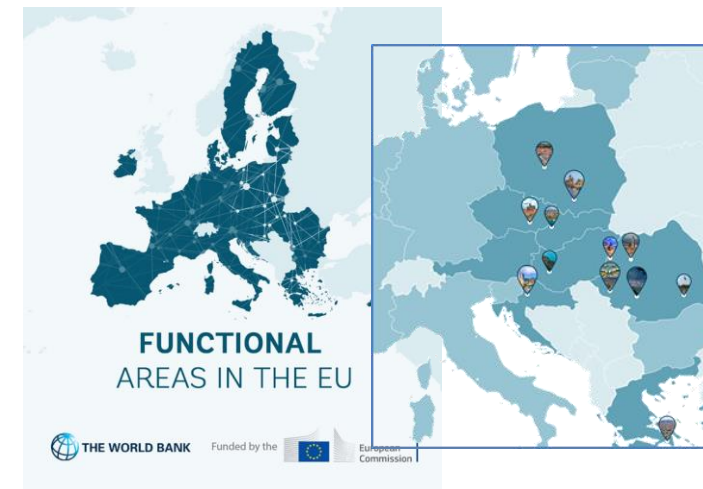

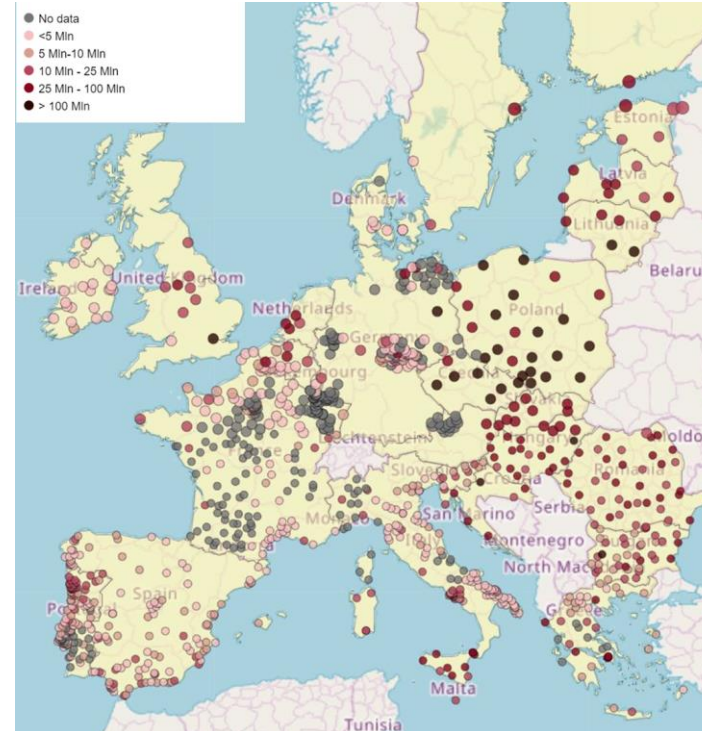
Population size

SUD strategies

- 44% target medium-sized urban areas, 41% small towns (<50.000 inhabitants)
- ITI strategies are, on average, targeting bigger territories

Other strategies

- 89% target areas with less than 250.000 inhabitants (incl. all CLLD)



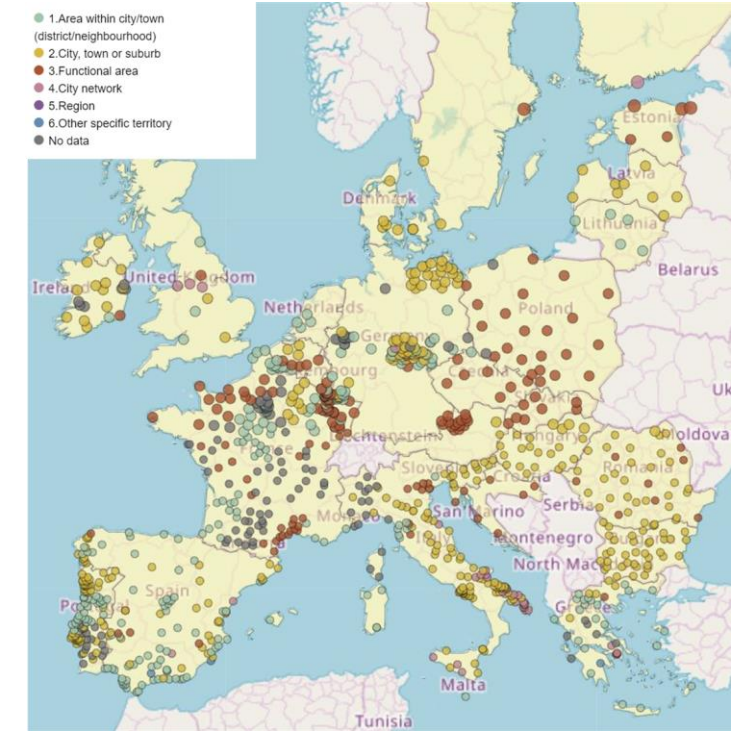
Financing

SUD strategies

- 40% of SUD strategies commit less than 5 million euros of ESIF
- 17% of SUD strategies integrate more than one fund (two third of them are ITI)

Other strategies

- 62% of CLLD strategies combine ERDF with EAFRD



Territorial focus

SUD strategies

- 45% cities, 31% neighbourhoods, 20% functional areas
- Around 50% of total ESIF budget go to strategies that target functional areas

Other strategies

- 14% of CLLD strategies target urban neighbourhoods
